## A Committed Partnership of Ordinary Citizens

The struggle for freedom began when the first African slaves arrived on our shores. For nearly 256 years Florida and St. Augustine were where African slaves came in search of freedom. Theirs was a risky and perilous journey through hundreds of miles of dense forests, treacherous swamps and endless mazes of coastal marshes. Most never made it, but a few did, Those who did make it were given their freedom by the Spanish. Given their importance to St. Augustine's economic survival and defense and El Pueblo de Gracia Real de Santa Teresa de Mose was founded in March 1738 by Spanish Governor Montiano. Located a couple miles north of the Castillo de San Marcos, Fort Mose, as we call it today, became the first free legally sanctioned Black settlement in continental USA.

This remarkable story of courage, determination and survival was only rediscovered in the last couple of decades through the hard work and leadership of dedicated and committed partnerships of ordinary citizens, political leaders and scholars.

Their efforts led to the establishment of Fort Mose Historic State Park in 1989 and the founding of the Fort Mose Historical Society in 1996, The state- of-the-art Visitors Center and Museum opened at the park in 2008.

Our work has only begun in telling this well-kept secret. Through your generous support to the Experience Fort Mose Project, we will accomplish this goal by raising \$150,000 to rebuild a representation of the 1738 fortification with educational interactive and interpretive displays and living history programs.
